



Immermove

Immermove is an experimental platform for the analysis of human movement and interaction, particularly in the field of sports. It is a 30 x 20 m² gymnasium fully equipped and dedicated to analyzing human motion. It also includes VR devices and a CAVE of 12m*4m*4m.

It is combined with Immersia, the VR platform in Irisa-Inria, in a unique collaborative immersive platform named "ImmerSTAR" (<https://www.irisa.fr/node/826>).
